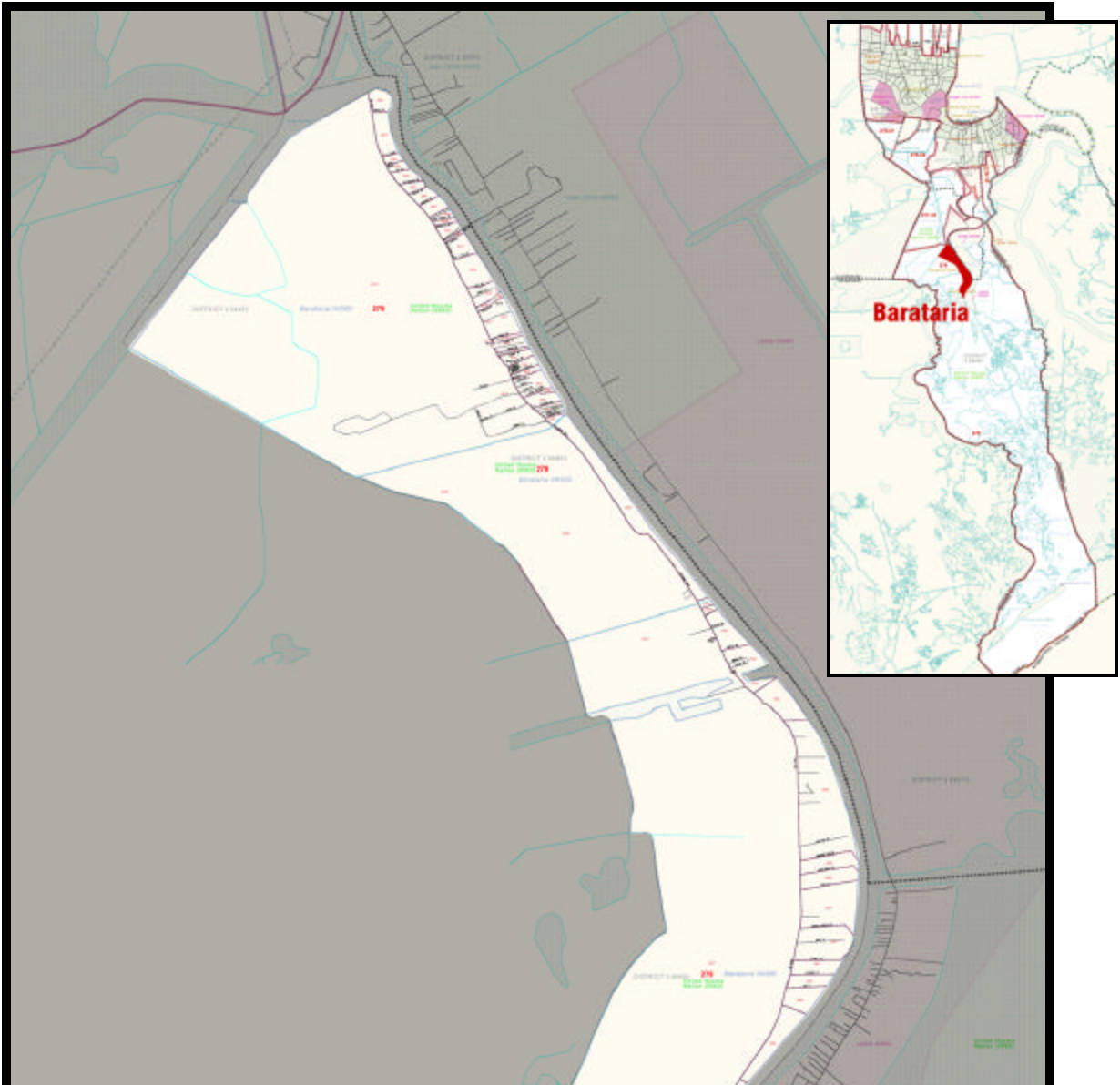

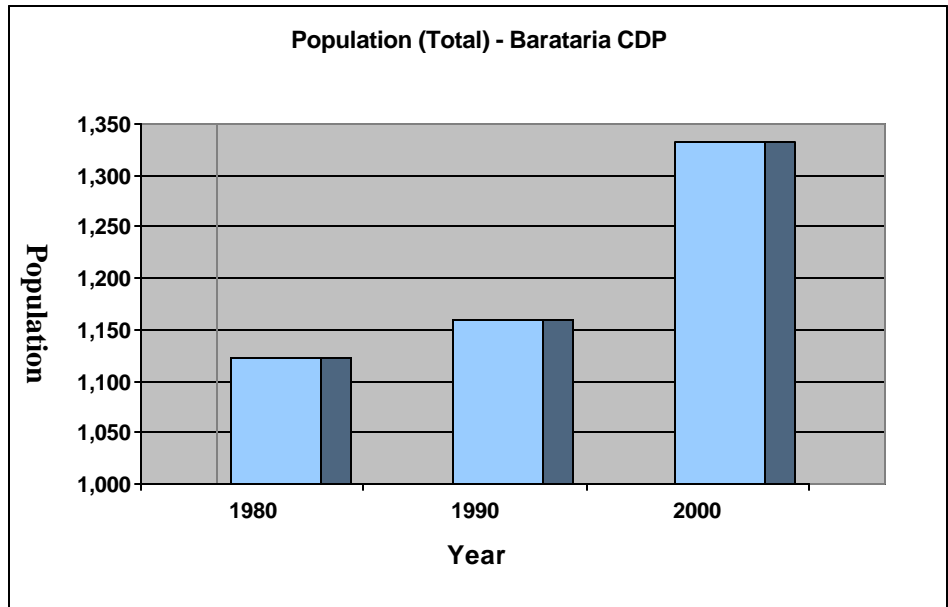

Barataria (CDP): Total Population

Total Population

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the total population of Barataria (CDP) to be 1,333. This is an increase of 173 persons or 14.9% from the 1990 Census (total population of 1,160 persons) and an increase of 210 persons or 18.7% from the 1980 Census (total population of 1,123 persons).



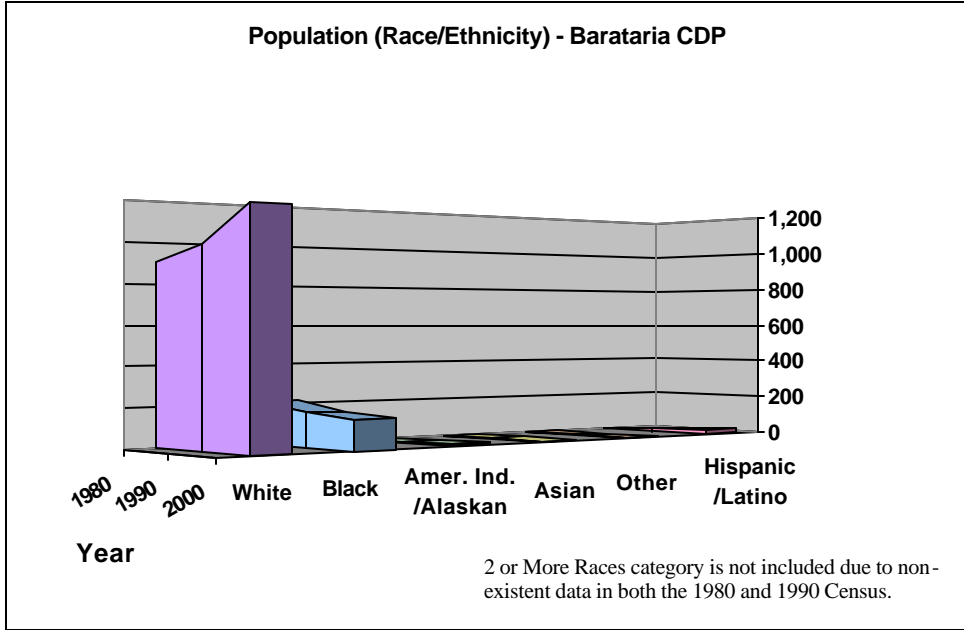
The 2000 Census indicates a total population for Barataria (CDP) at 1,333 persons. This is a 14.9% increase (173 persons) since 1990 and a 18.7% increase (210 persons) since 1980.

Barataria (CDP): Racial/Ethnic Demographics



The 2000 Census reports the racial composition of Barataria (CDP) to be 1,159 persons or 87.0% White; 148 persons or 11.1% Black/African American; 8 persons or 0.6% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 0 persons or 0.0% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 3 persons or 0.2% of Some Other Race.

The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 25 persons or 1.9% of the total population.

Racial and Ethnic Demographics

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the racial composition of Barataria (CDP) to be 1,159 persons or 87.0% White; 148 persons or 11.1% Black/African American; 8 persons or 0.6% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 0 persons or 0.0% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 3 persons or 0.2% of Some Other Race. The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 25 persons or 1.9% of the total population. Additionally, the 2000 Census introduces a new category for multiracial identity. The population reporting Two or More Races includes 15 persons or 1.1% of the total population.

The White population (1,159 persons or 87.0% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 179 persons or 18.3% from the 1990 Census (White population of 980 persons or 84.5% of the total population in 1990) and an increase of 254 persons or 28.1% from the 1980 Census (White population of 905 persons or 80.6% of the total population in 1980).

The Black/African American population (148 persons or 11.1% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a decrease of 22 persons or 12.9% from the 1990 Census (Black/African American population of 170 persons or 14.7% of the total population in 1990) and a decrease of 63 persons

or 29.9% from the 1980 Census (Black/African American population of 211 persons or 18.8% of the total population in 1980).

The American Indian/Alaskan Native population (8 persons or 0.6% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a change of 0 persons or 0.0% from the 1990 Census (American Indian/Alaskan Native population of 8 persons or 0.7% of the total population in 1990).

The Asian/Pacific Islander population (0 persons or 0.0% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a decrease of 1 persons or 100.0% from the 1990 Census (Asian/Pacific Islander population of 1 person or 0.1% of the total population in 1990).

The population that is categorized as Some Other Race (3 persons or 0.2% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 2 persons or 200.0% from the 1990 Census (Some Other Race population of 1 person or 0.1% of the total population in 1990).

The 2000 Census reports that the population of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is 25 persons or 1.9% of the total population. This is an increase of 10 persons or 66.7% from the 1990 Census (Hispanic/Latino population of 15 persons or 1.3% of the total population in 1990).

Barataria (CDP): Age & Sex Demographics

Age Demographics

The 2000 Census reports the Age breakdown for Barataria (CDP) at 315 persons or 23.6% of the total population are under eighteen years of age, 835 persons or 62.6% of the total population are eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 183 persons or 13.7% of the total population are sixty-five years and older.

The 1990 Census reported the Age breakdown for Barataria (CDP) at 311 persons or 26.8% of the total population were under eighteen years of age, 713 persons or 61.5% of the total population were from eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 136 persons or 11.7% of the total population were sixty-five years and older.

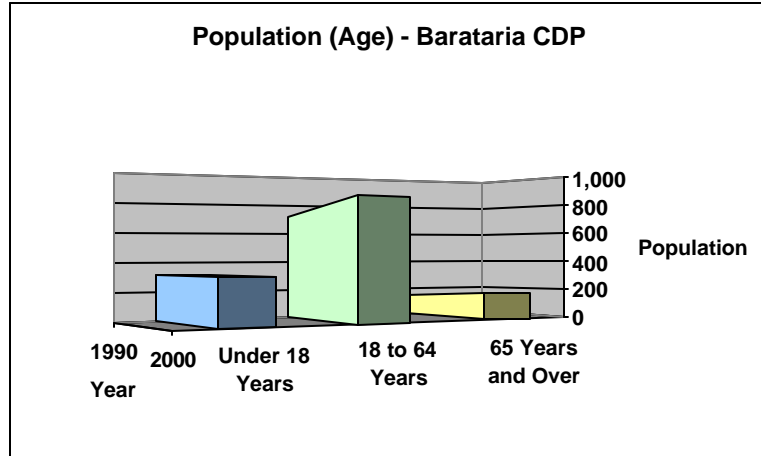
This shows an increase from 1990 to 2000 for the population under eighteen years of age at 4 persons or 1.3%, an increase for the population eighteen to sixty-four years of age at 122 persons or 17.1%, and an increase in the population sixty-five years and older at 47 persons or 34.6%.

Sex Demographics

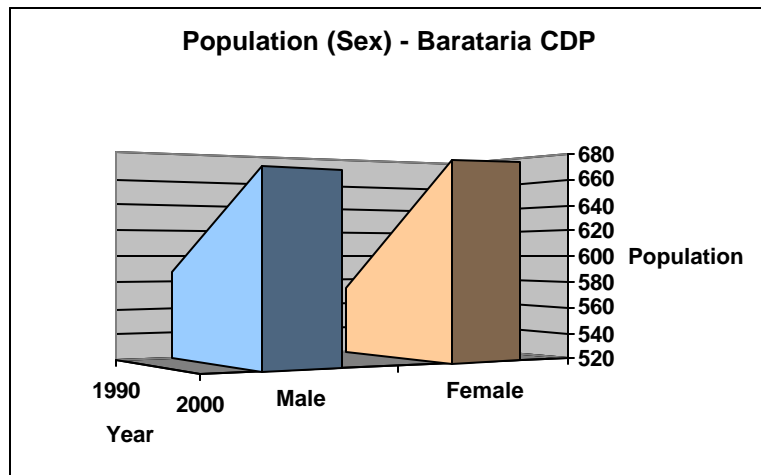
The 2000 Census reports the Sex breakdown for Barataria (CDP) as 661 persons or 49.6% of the total population are Male and 672 persons or 50.4% of the total population are Female.

The 1990 Census reported the Sex breakdown for Barataria (CDP) as 588 persons or 50.7% of the total population were Male and 572 persons or 49.3% of the total population were Female.

This shows an increase in the population from 1990 to 2000 for the Male population of 73 persons or 12.4% and an increase for the Female population of 100 persons or 17.5%.



The 2000 Census calculates the population under eighteen years of age at 23.6% (315 persons), the population from eighteen to sixty-four years of age at 62.6% (835 persons), and the population sixty-five years and older at 13.7% (183 persons). This shows a 1.3% increase in the population under eighteen years of age, a 17.1% increase in the population eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and an increase of 34.6% in the population aged sixty-five years and older since 1990.

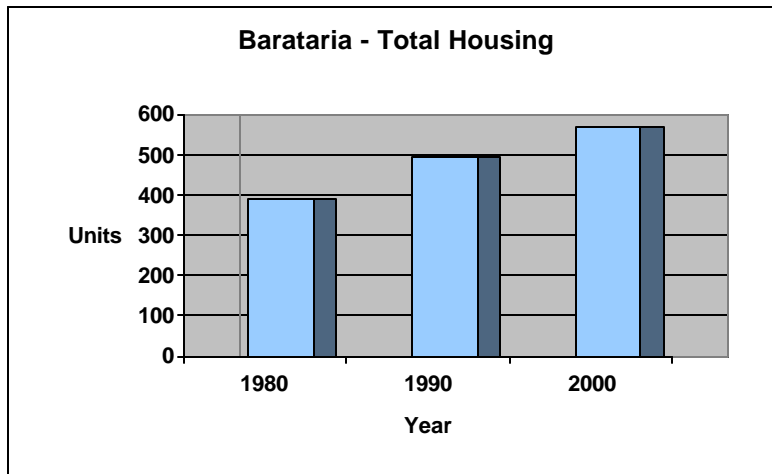


The 2000 Census indicates the population to be 49.6% male (661 persons) and 50.4% female (672 persons). This shows an increase of 12.4% for the male population and an increase of 17.5% in the female population since 1990.

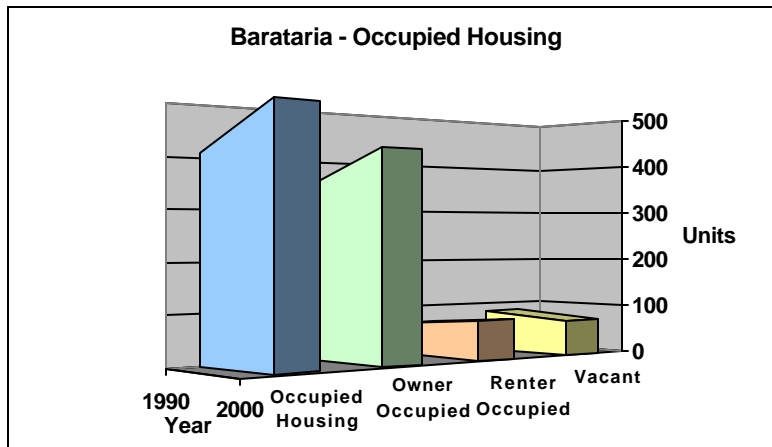

The 2000 Census indicates 571 total housing units. This is a 15.1% gain since 1990 and a 45.7% gain since 1980.



The 2000 Census shows an occupancy rate of 87.6% or 500 occupied housing units. This is a 22.0% gain in occupied housing since the 1990 Census.

Total Housing

The 2000 Census indicates that Barataria (CDP) has 571 total housing units. This is a 75 housing unit increase or a 15.1% gain since the 1990 Census (496 total housing units) and a 179 housing unit increase or a 45.7% gain over the 1980 Census (392 total housing units).

Housing Occupancy

The 2000 Census indicates that Barataria (CDP) has 500 occupied housing units or 87.6% of total housing. This is a 90 occupied unit increase or a 22.0% gain since the 1990 Census (410 occupied housing units or 82.7% of total housing in 1990).

Owner occupied housing consists of 420 occupied units or 84.0% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 78 units or 22.8% in owner occupied housing since the 1990 Census (342 owner occupied housing units or 83.4% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

Renter occupied housing consists of 80 occupied units or 16.0% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 12 units or 17.7% in renter occupied housing since the 1990 Census (68 renter occupied housing units or 16.6% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

Barataria (CDP): Housing Characteristics

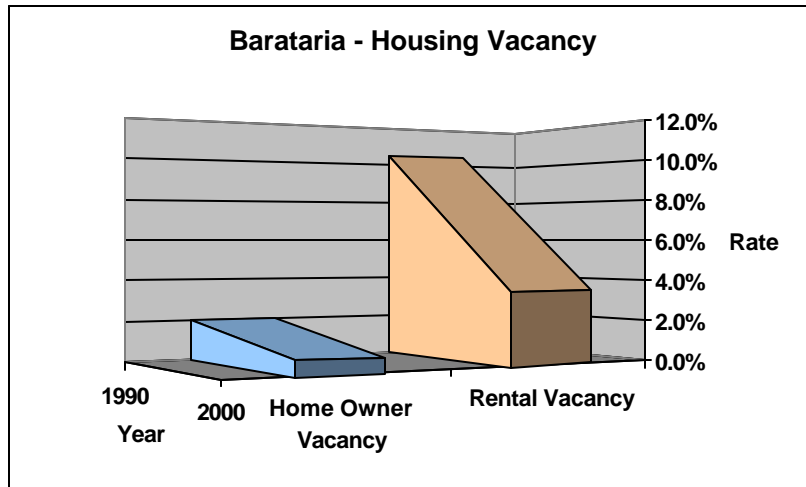
Vacant Housing

Vacant housing consists of 71 unoccupied units or 12.4% of total housing, which includes 51 units that are classified as seasonal/recreational/occasional use. This is a decrease of 15 units or 17.4% in vacant housing since the 1990 Census (86 vacant housing units or 17.3% of the total housing in 1990).

Vacancy Rate

The Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 0.7% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate decrease of 1.3% or a 65.0 percent change since the 1990 Census (2.0% Homeowner Vacancy Rate in 1990).

The Rental Vacancy Rate is 3.6% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate decrease of 6.9% or a 65.7 percent change since the 1990 Census (10.5% Rental Vacancy



The 2000 Census indicates that the Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 0.7% and the Rental Vacancy Rate is 3.6%.

POPULATION HIGHLIGHTS

Barataria (CDP) is experiencing a consistent increase in total population since the 1980 Census (14.9% since 1990 and 18.7% since 1980). The primary factor for this increase is the expansion in the White population (18.3% since 1990 and 28.1% since 1980). However, this trend is somewhat offset by a steady decrease in the Black/African American population (-12.9% since 1990 and -29.9% since 1980).

The population has also seen a dramatic increase in the senior population defined as sixty-five years and older. The 2000 Census shows a 34.6% increase in the sixty-five years and older demographic since 1990.
