

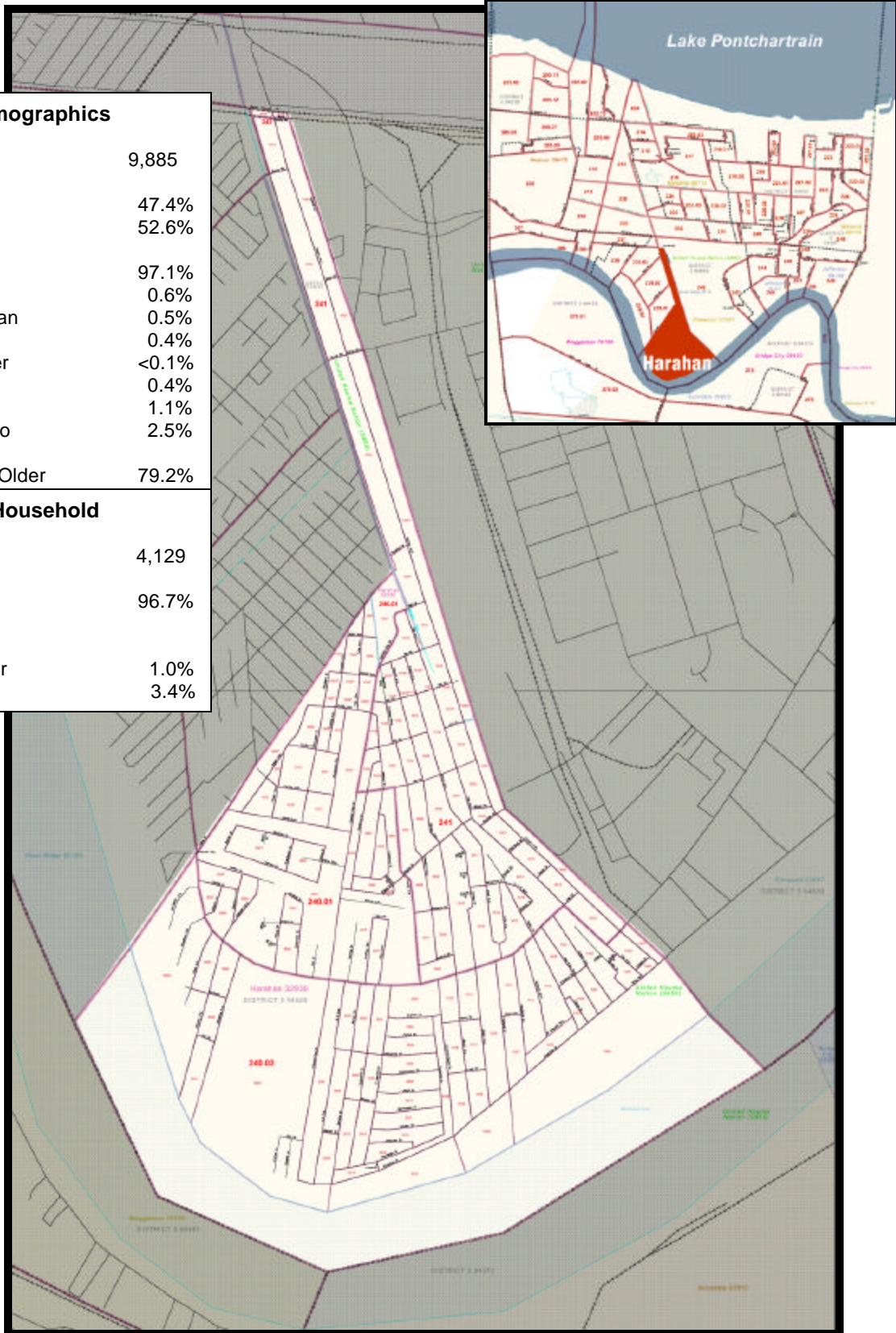

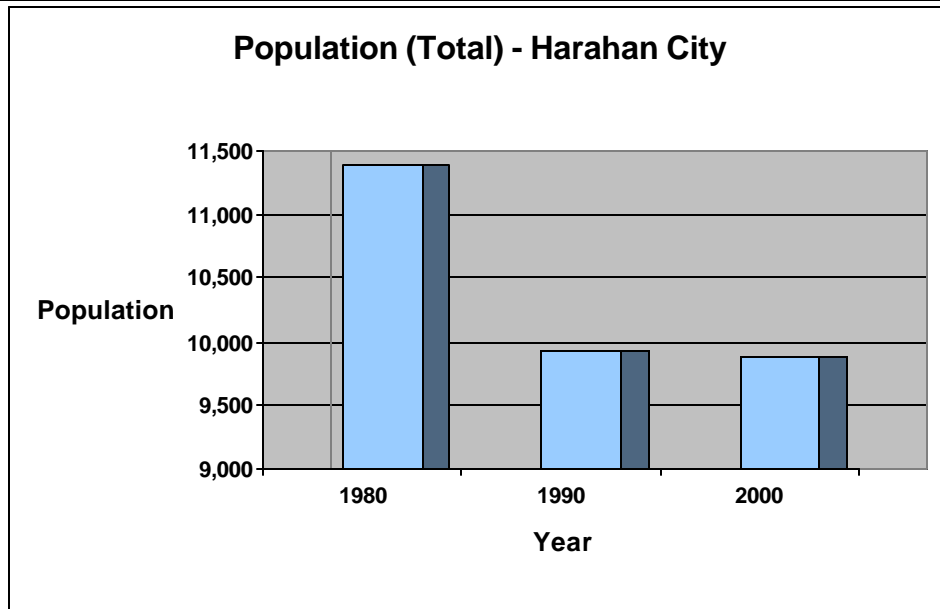

Harahan (City): Total Population

Total Population

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the total population of Harahan (City) to be 9,885 persons. This is a decrease of 42 persons or 0.4% from the 1990 Census (total population of 9,927 persons) and a decrease of 1,499 persons or 13.2% from the 1980 Census (total population of 11,384 persons).



The 2000 Census reports the total population of Harahan (City) to be 9,885 persons. This is a decrease of 42 persons or 0.4% from the 1990 Census and a decrease of 1,499 persons or 13.2% from the 1980 Census.

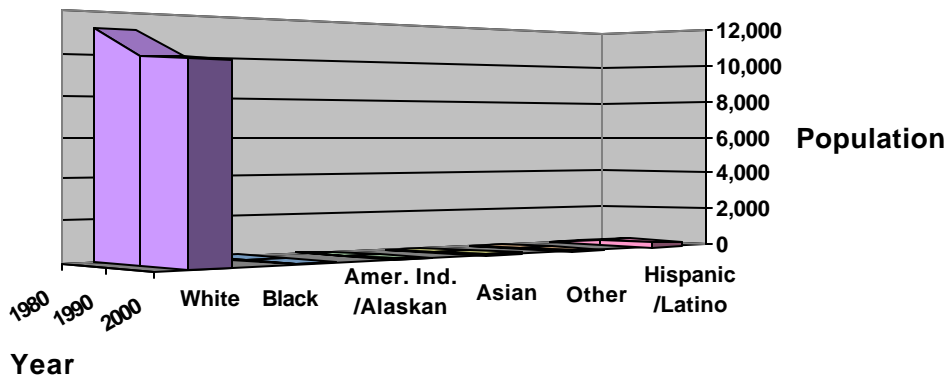

Harahan (City): Racial/Ethnic Demographics

Population (Race/Ethnicity) - Harahan City



The 2000 Census reports the racial composition of Harahan (City) to be 9,594 persons or 97.1% White; 61 persons or 0.6% Black/African American; 44 persons or 0.5% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 40 persons or 0.4% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 37 persons or 0.4% of Some Other Race.

The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 243 persons or 2.5% of the total population.

2 or More Races category is not included due to non-existent data in both the 1980 and 1990 Census.

Racial and Ethnic Demographics

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the racial composition of Harahan (City) to be 9,594 persons or 97.1% White; 61 persons or 0.6% Black/African American; 44 persons or 0.5% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 40 persons or 0.4% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 37 persons or 0.4% of Some Other Race. The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 243 persons or 2.5% of the total population. Additionally, the 2000 Census introduces a new category for multiracial identity. The population reporting Two or More Races includes 109 persons or 1.1% of the total population.

The White population (9,594 persons or 97.1% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a decrease of 220 persons or 2.2% from the 1990 Census (White population of 9,814 persons or 98.9% of the total population in 1990) and a decrease of 1,662 persons or 14.8% from the 1980 Census (White population of 11,256 persons or 98.9% of the total population in 1980).

The Black/African American population (61 persons or 0.6% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 42 persons or 221.1% from the 1990 Census (Black/African American population of 19 persons or 0.2% of the total population in 1990) and an increase of 29 persons or

90.6% from the 1980 Census (Black/African American population of 32 persons or 0.3% of the total population in 1980).

The American Indian/Alaskan Native population (44 persons or 0.5% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 14 persons or 46.7% from the 1990 Census (American Indian/Alaskan Native population of 30 persons or 0.3% of the total population in 1990).

The Asian/Pacific Islander population (40 persons or 0.4% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 3 persons or 8.1% from the 1990 Census (Asian/Pacific Islander population of 37 persons or 0.4% of the total population in 1990).

The population that is categorized as Some Other Race (37 persons or 0.4% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 10 persons or 37.0% from the 1990 Census (Some Other Race population of 27 persons or 0.3% of the total population in 1990).

The 2000 Census reports that the population of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is 243 persons or 2.5% of the total population. This is a decrease of 21 persons or 8.0% from the 1990 Census (Hispanic/Latino population of 264 persons or 2.7% of the total population in 1990).

Harahan (City): Age & Sex Demographics

Age Demographics

The 2000 Census reports the Age breakdown for Harahan (City) at 2,058 persons or 20.8% of the total population are under eighteen years of age, 5,872 persons or 59.4% of the total population are eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 1,955 persons or 19.8% of the total population are sixty-five years and older.

The 1990 Census reported the Age breakdown for Harahan (City) at 2,238 persons or 22.5% of the total population were under eighteen years of age, 6,105 persons or 61.5% of the total population were from eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 1,584 persons or 16.0% of the total population were sixty-five years and older.

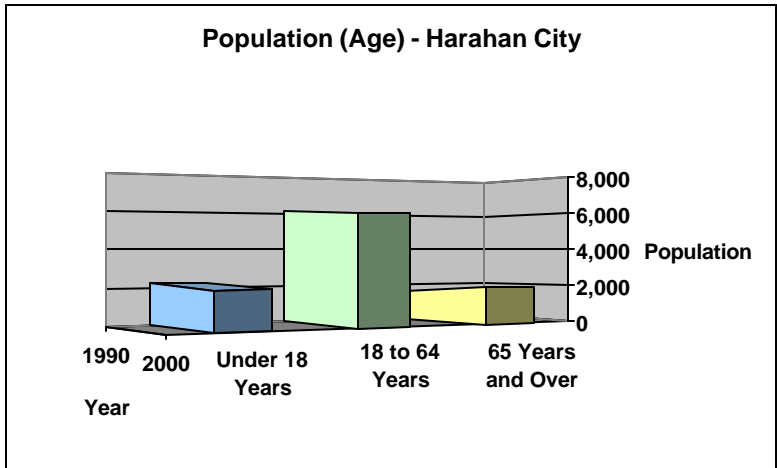
This shows a decrease from 1990 to 2000 for the population under eighteen years of age at 180 persons or 8.0%, a decrease for the population eighteen to sixty-four years of age at 233 persons or 3.8%, and an increase in the population sixty-five years and older at 371 persons or 23.4%.

Sex Demographics

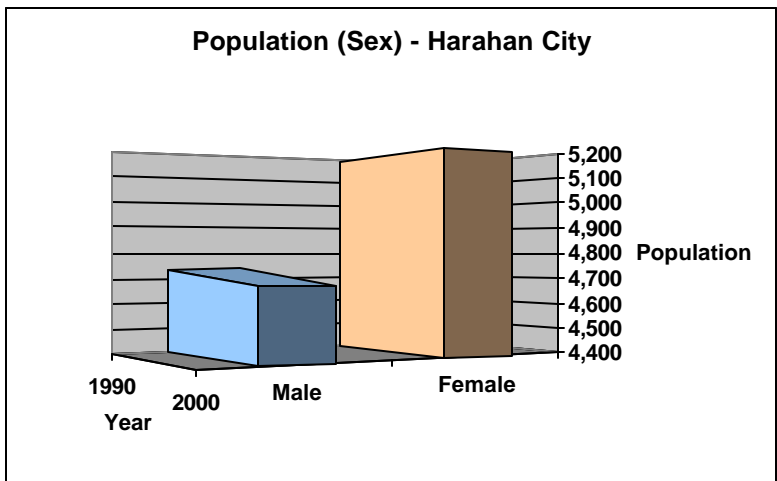
The 2000 Census reports the Sex breakdown for Harahan (City) as 4,686 persons or 47.4% of the total population are Male and 5,199 persons or 52.6% of the total population are Female.

The 1990 Census reported the Sex breakdown for Harahan (City) as 4,738 persons or 47.7% of the total population were Male and 5,189 persons or 52.3% of the total population were Female.

This shows a decrease from 1990 to 2000 for the Male population of 52 persons or 1.1% and an increase for the Female population of 10 persons or 0.2%.



The 2000 Census reports the Age breakdown for Harahan (City) at 2,058 persons or 20.8% are under eighteen years of age, 5,872 persons or 59.4% are eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 1,955 persons or 19.8% are sixty-five years and older. This shows a 8.0% decrease for the population under eighteen years of age, a 3.8% decrease for the population eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and a 23.4% increase in the population sixty-five years and older.

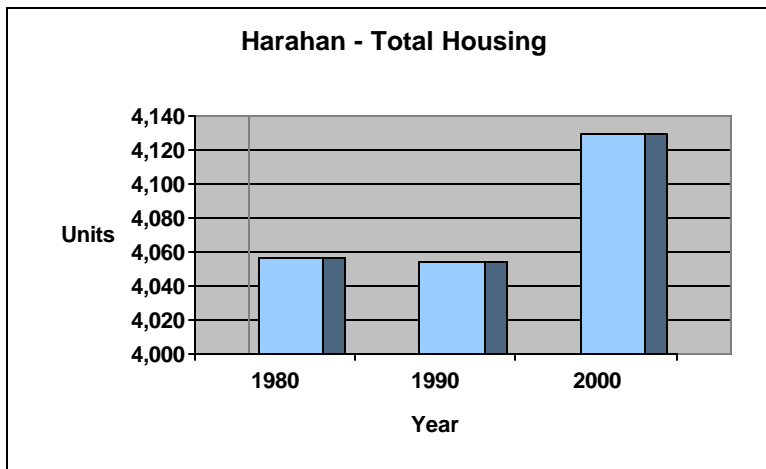


The 2000 Census reports the Sex breakdown for Harahan (City) as 4,686 persons or 47.4% are Male and 5,199 persons or 52.6% are Female. This shows a 1.1% decrease from 1990 to 2000 for the Male population and a 0.2% increase for the Female population.

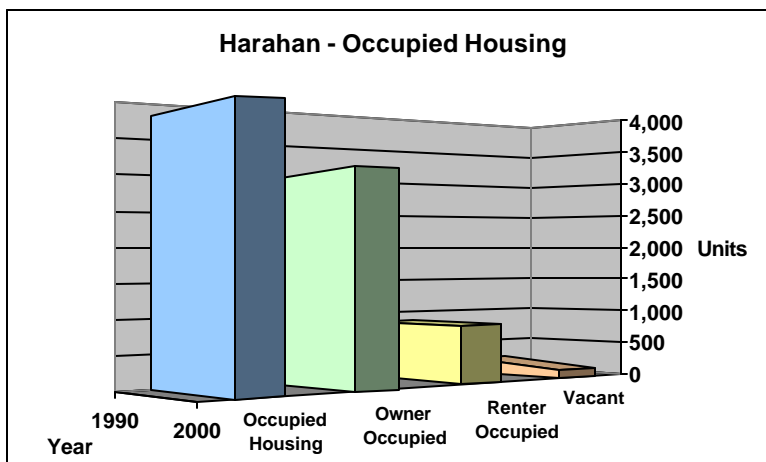

The 2000 Census indicates that Harahan (City) has 4,129 total housing units. This is a 1.9% gain since the 1990 Census and a 1.8% gain over the 1980 Census.



The 2000 Census indicates that Harahan (City) has 3,994 occupied housing units or 96.7% of total housing. This is a 4.0% gain since the 1990 Census.

Total Housing

The 2000 Census indicates that Harahan (City) has 4,129 total housing units. This is 75 housing units higher or a 1.9% gain since the 1990 Census, which had a total of 4,054 housing units. Total housing units available in the 2000 Census are 72 units higher or a 1.8% gain over the 1980 Census, which had a total of 4,057 housing units.

Housing Occupancy

The 2000 Census indicates that Harahan (City) has 3,994 occupied housing units or 96.7% of total housing. This is a 155 occupied unit increase or a 4.0% gain since the 1990 Census (3,839 occupied housing units or 94.7% of total housing in 1990).

Owner occupied housing consists of 3,126 occupied units or 78.3% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 134 units or 4.5% in owner occupied housing since the 1990 Census (2,992 owner occupied housing units or 77.9% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

Renter occupied housing consists of 868 occupied units or 21.7% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 21 units or 2.5% in renter occupied housing since the 1990 Census (847 renter occupied housing units or 22.1% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

Harahan (City): Housing Characteristics

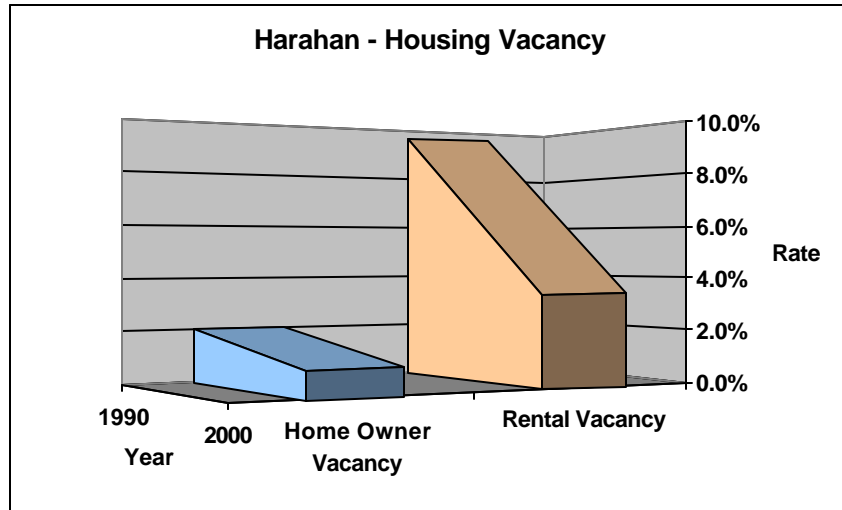
Vacant Housing

Vacant housing consists of 135 unoccupied units or 3.3% of total housing, which includes 8 units that are classified as seasonal/recreational/occasional use. This is a decrease of 80 units or 37.2% in vacant housing since the 1990 Census (215 vacant housing units or 5.3% of the total housing in 1990).

Vacancy Rate

The Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 1.0% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate decrease of 1.0% or a 50.0 percent change since the 1990 Census (2.0% Homeowner Vacancy Rate in 1990).

The Rental Vacancy Rate is 3.4% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate decrease of 6.3% or a 64.9 percent change since the 1990 Census (9.7% Rental Vacancy Rate in 1990).



The 2000 Census indicates that the Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 1.0% and the Rental Vacancy Rate is 3.4%.

POPULATION HIGHLIGHTS

Harahan (City) has experienced a decrease in total population since the 1980 Census (-0.4% since 1990 and -13.2% since 1980). The primary factor for this decrease is the reduction in the White population (-2.2% since 1990 and -14.8% since 1980).

The population has also seen a dramatic increase in the senior population defined as sixty-five years and older. The 2000 Census shows a 23.4% increase in the sixty-five years and older demographic since 1990.
