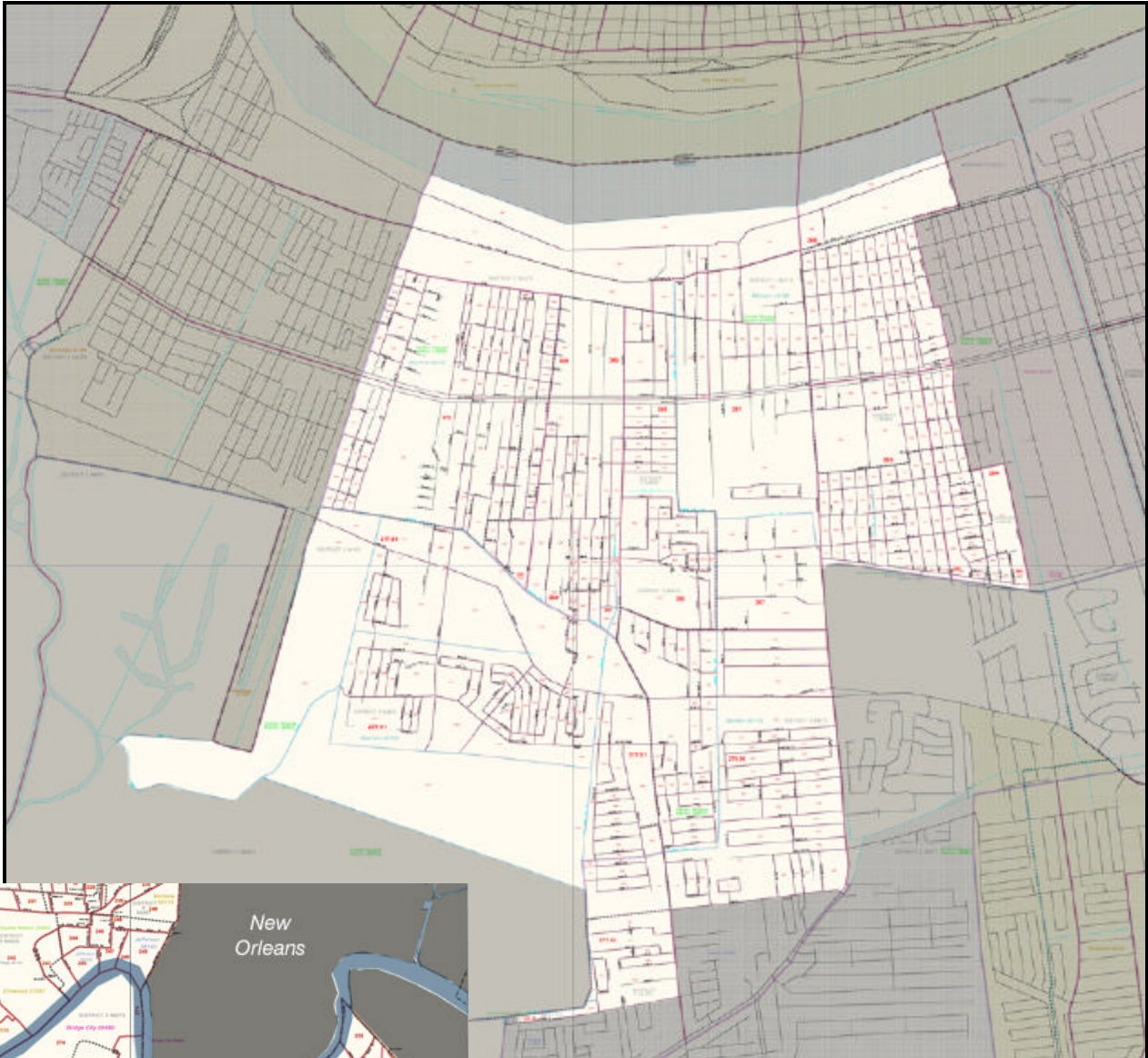

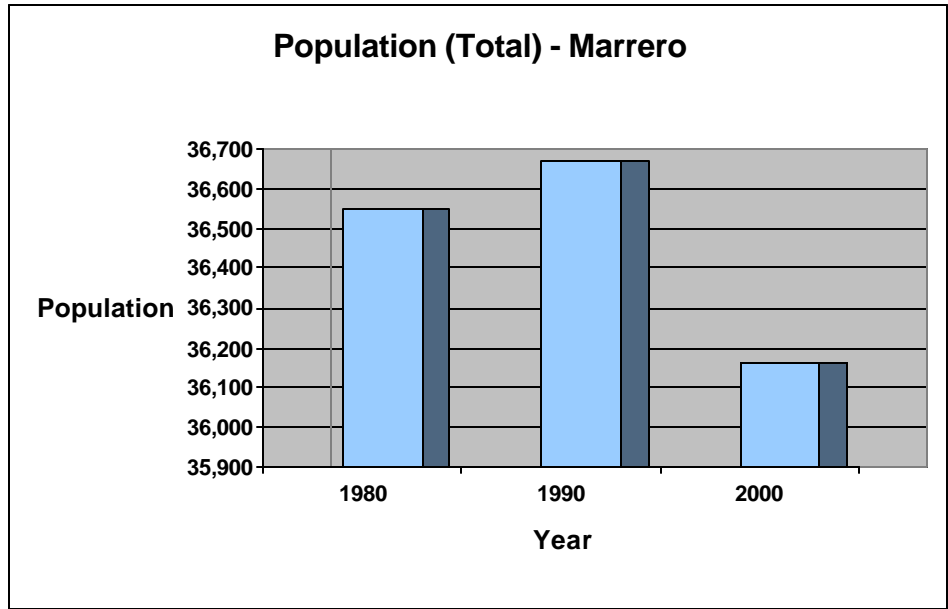

Marrero (CDP): Total Population

Total Population

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the total population of Marrero CDP to be 36,165 persons. This is a decrease of 506 persons or 1.4% from the 1990 Census (total population of 36,671 persons) and a decrease of 383 persons or 1.1% from the 1980 Census (total population of 36,548 persons).



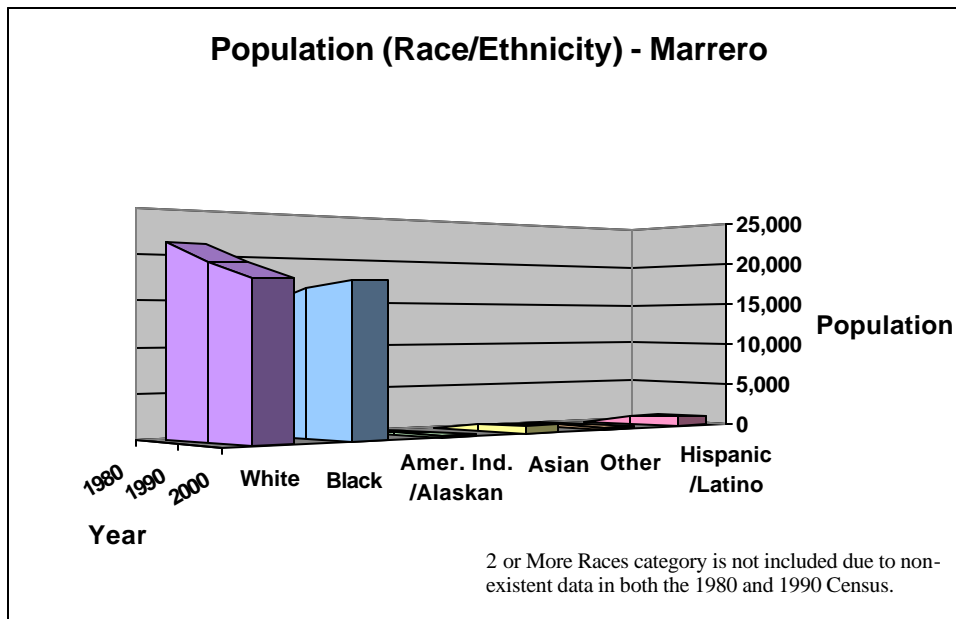

Marrero (CDP): Racial/Ethnic Demographics



The 2000 Census reports the racial composition of Marrero (CDP) to be 17,171 persons or 47.5% White; 17,246 persons or 47.7% Black/African American; 141 persons or 0.4% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 908 persons or 2.5% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 258 persons or 0.7% of Some Other Race.

The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 1,127 persons or 3.1% of the total population.

Racial and Ethnic Demographics

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the racial composition of Marrero (CDP) to be 17,171 persons or 47.5% White; 17,246 persons or 47.7% Black/African American; 141 persons or 0.4% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 908 persons or 2.5% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 258 persons or 0.7% of Some Other Race. The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 1,127 persons or 3.1% of the total population. Additionally, the 2000 Census introduces a new category for multiracial identity. The population reporting Two or More Races includes 441 persons or 1.2% of the total population.

The White population (17,171 persons or 47.5% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a decrease of 1,867 persons or 9.8% from the 1990 Census (White population of 19,038 persons or 51.9% of the total population in 1990) and a decrease of 4,154 persons or 19.5% from the 1980 Census (White population of 21,325 persons or 58.4% of the total population in 1980).

The Black/African American population (17,246 persons or 47.7% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 733 persons or 4.4% from the 1990 Census (Black/African American population of 16,513 persons or 45.0% of the total population in 1990) and an increase of 2,666 per-

sons or 18.3% from the 1980 Census (Black/African American population of 14,580 persons or 39.9% of the total population in 1980).

The American Indian/Alaskan Native population (141 persons or 0.4% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a decrease of 40 persons or 22.1% from the 1990 Census (American Indian/Alaskan Native population of 181 persons or 0.5% of the total population in 1990).

The Asian/Pacific Islander population (908 persons or 2.5% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 199 persons or 28.1% from the 1990 Census (Asian/Pacific Islander population of 709 persons or 1.9% of the total population in 1990).

The population that is categorized as Some Other Race (258 persons or 0.7% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 28 persons or 12.2% from the 1990 Census (Some Other Race population of 230 persons or 0.6% of the total population in 1990).

The 2000 Census reports that the population of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is 1,127 persons or 3.1% of the total population. This is an increase of 72 persons or 6.8% from the 1990 Census (Hispanic/Latino population of 1,055 persons or 2.9% of the total population in 1990).

Marrero (CDP): Age & Sex Demographics

Age Demographics

The 2000 Census reports the Age breakdown for Marrero (CDP) at 10,502 persons or 29.0% of the total population are under eighteen years of age, 21,427 persons or 59.2% of the total population are eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 4,236 persons or 11.7% of the total population are sixty-five years and older.

The 1990 Census reported the Age breakdown for Marrero (CDP) at 11,731 persons or 32.0% of the total population were under eighteen years of age, 21,542 persons or 58.7% of the total population were from eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 3,398 persons or 9.3% of the total population were sixty-five years and older.

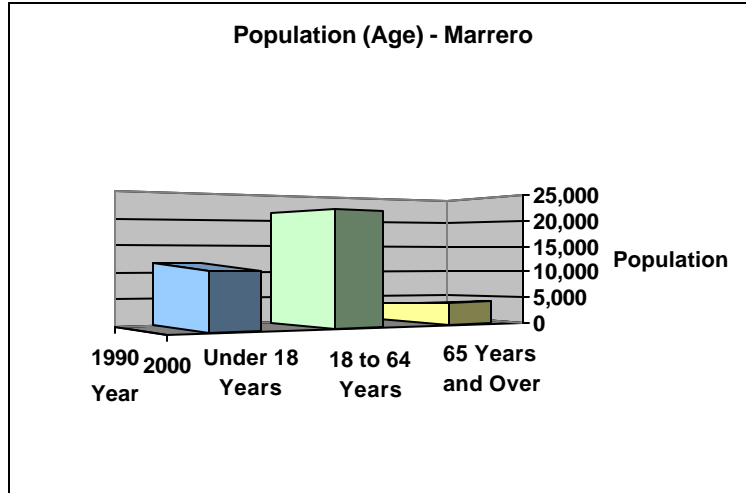
This shows a decrease from 1990 to 2000 for the population under eighteen years of age at 1,229 persons or 10.5%, a decrease for the population eighteen to sixty-four years of age at 115 persons or 0.5%, and an increase in the population sixty-five years and older at 838 persons or 24.7%.

Sex Demographics

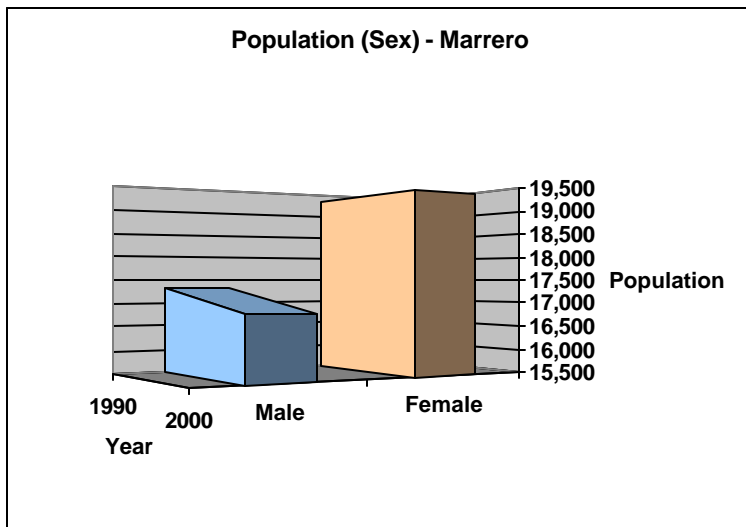
The 2000 Census reports the Sex breakdown for Marrero (CDP) as 16,831 persons or 46.5% of the total population are Male and 19,334 persons or 53.5% of the total population are Female.

The 1990 Census reported the Sex breakdown for Marrero (CDP) as 17,331 persons or 47.3% of the total population were Male and 19,340 persons or 52.7% of the total population were Female.

This shows a decrease in the population from 1990 to 2000 for the Male population of 500 persons or 2.9% and a decrease for the Female population of 6 persons or <0.1%.



The 2000 Census reports the Age breakdown for Marrero (CDP) at 10,502 persons or 29.0% are under eighteen years of age, 21,427 persons or 59.2% are eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 4,236 persons or 11.7% are sixty-five years and older. This shows a decrease from 1990 to 2000 for the population under eighteen years of age at 1,229 persons or 10.5%, a decrease for the population eighteen to sixty-four years of age at 115 persons or 0.5%, and an increase in the population sixty-five years and older at 838 persons or 24.7%.

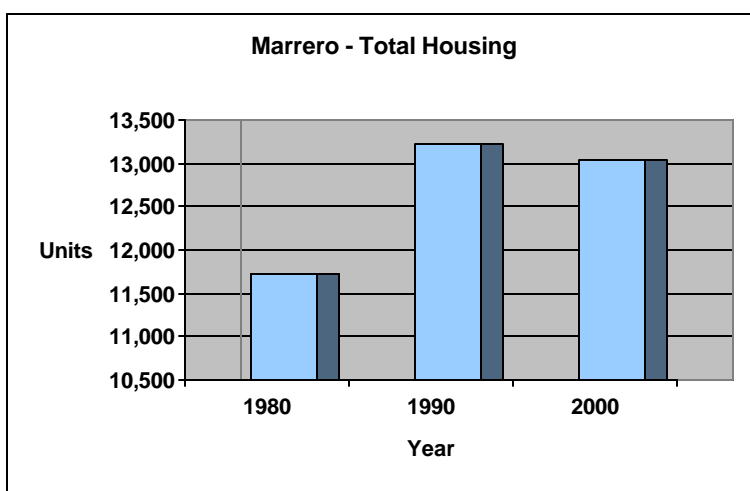


The 2000 Census reports the Sex breakdown for Marrero (CDP) as 16,831 persons or 46.5% Male and 19,334 persons or 53.5% Female. This shows a decrease in the population from 1990 to 2000 for the Male population of 500 persons or 2.9% and a decrease for the Female population of 6 persons or <0.1%.

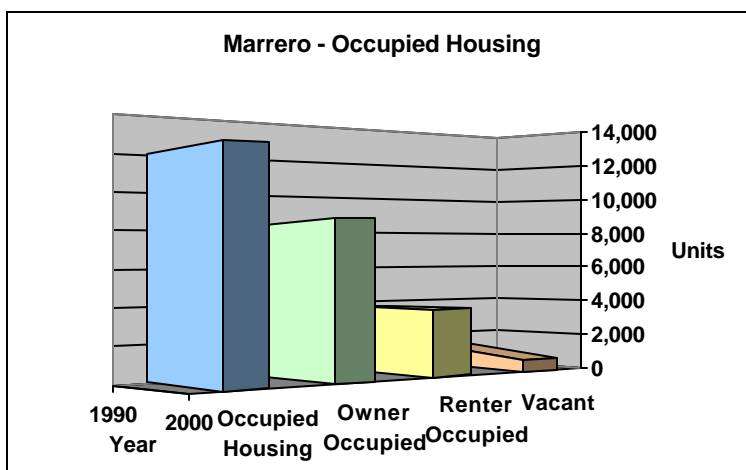

The 2000 Census indicates that Marrero (CDP) has 13,046 total housing units. This is a 174 housing unit decrease or a 1.3% loss since the 1990 Census and a 1,321 housing unit increase or a 11.3% gain over the 1980 Census (11,725 total housing units).



The 2000 Census indicates that Marrero (CDP) has 12,432 occupied housing units or 95.3% of the total housing units. This is a 384 occupied unit increase or a 3.2% gain since the 1990 Census.

Total Housing

The 2000 Census indicates that Marrero (CDP) has 13,046 total housing units. This is a 174 housing unit decrease or a 1.3% loss since the 1990 Census (13,220 total housing units) and a 1,321 housing unit increase or a 11.3% gain over the 1980 Census (11,725 total housing units).

Housing Occupancy

The 2000 Census indicates that Marrero (CDP) has 12,432 occupied housing units or 95.3% of total housing. This is a 384 occupied unit increase or a 3.2% gain since the 1990 Census (12,048 occupied housing units or 91.1% of total housing in 1990).

Owner occupied housing consists of 8,697 occupied units or 70.0% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 369 units or 4.4% in owner occupied housing since the 1990 Census (8,328 owner occupied housing units or 69.1% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

Renter occupied housing consists of 3,735 occupied units or 30.0% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 15 units or a 0.4% gain in renter occupied housing since the 1990 Census (3,720 renter occupied housing units or 30.9% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

Marrero (CDP): Housing Characteristics

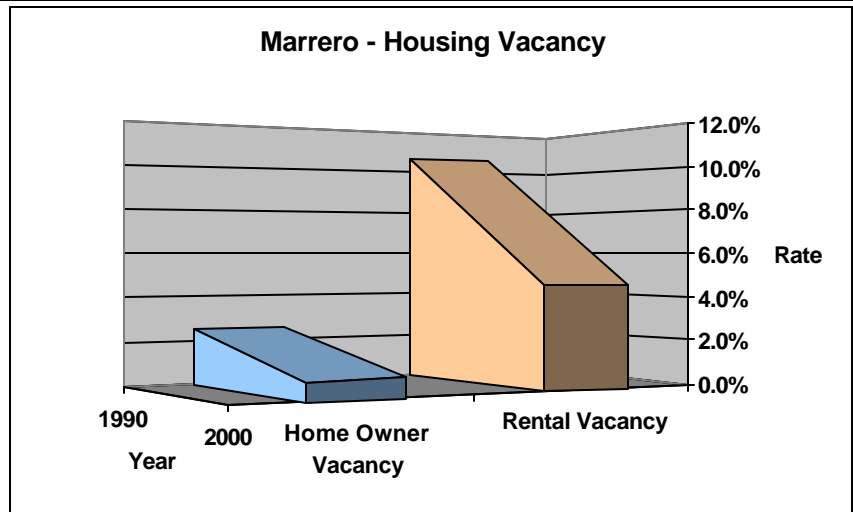
Vacant Housing

Vacant housing consists of 614 unoccupied units or 4.7% of total housing, which includes 20 units that are classified as seasonal/recreational/occasional use. This is a decrease of 558 units or 47.6% in vacant housing since the 1990 Census (1,172 vacant housing units or 8.9% of the total housing in 1990).

Vacancy Rate

The Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 0.8% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate decrease of 1.7% or a 68.0 percent change since the 1990 Census (2.5% Homeowner Vacancy Rate in 1990).

The Rental Vacancy Rate is 4.6% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate decrease of 6.1% or a 57.0 percent change since the 1990 Census (10.7% Rental Vacancy Rate in 1990).



As of the 2000 Census, the Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 0.8% and the Rental Vacancy Rate is 4.6%.

POPULATION HIGHLIGHTS

Marrero (CDP) has experienced a decline in total population (-1.1% since 1980 and -1.4% since 1990). The primary factor for this trend is the decreasing White population (-19.5% since 1980 and -9.8% since 1990). The decrease has been partially offset by the increase in the Black/African American population (18.3% since 1980 and 4.4% since 1990).

The population under the age of 18 shows a decrease of 10.5% since 1990. The population aged 65 years and over shows an increase of 24.6%.
