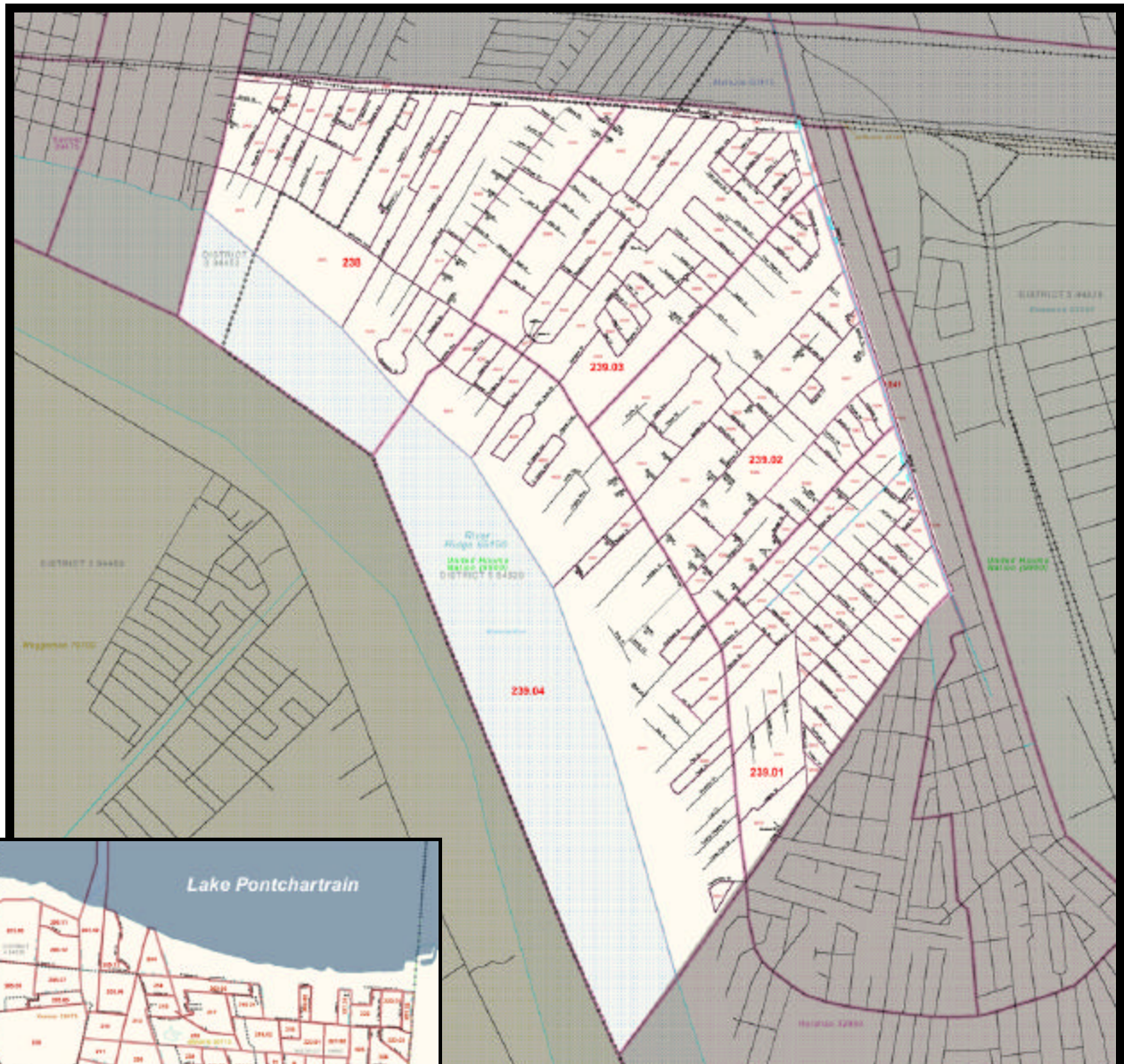

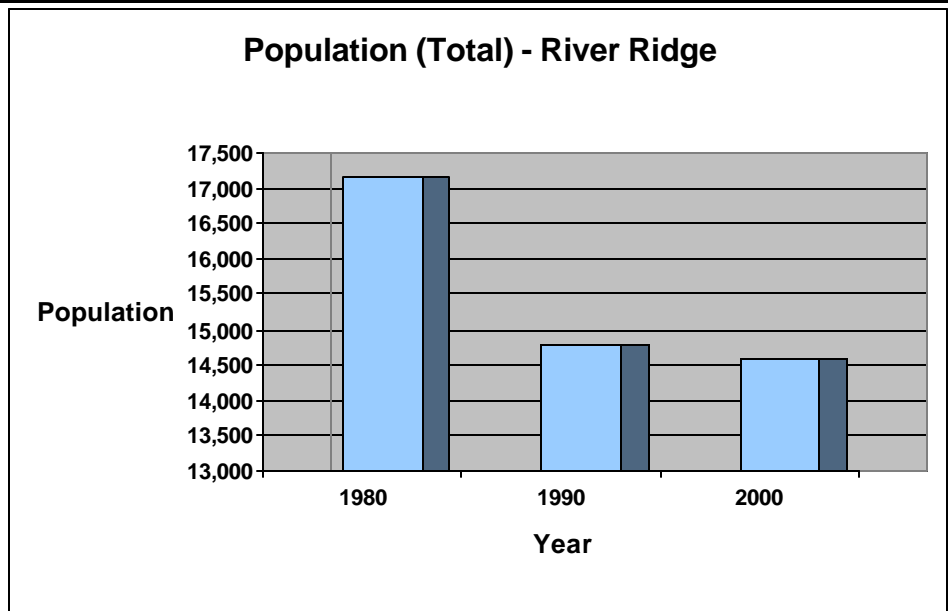

River Ridge (CDP): Total Population

Total Population

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the total population of River Ridge (CDP) to be 14,588 persons. This is a decrease of 212 persons or 1.4% from the 1990 Census (total population of 14,800 persons) and a decrease of 2,558 persons or 14.9% from the 1980 Census (total population of 17,146 persons).



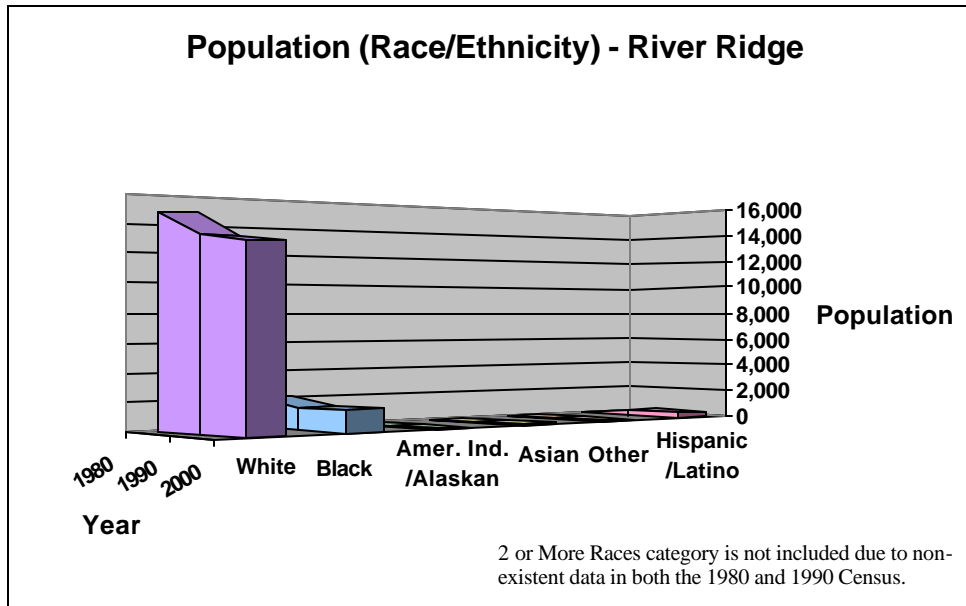

River Ridge (CDP): Racial/Ethnic Demographics



The 2000 Census reports the racial composition of River Ridge (CDP) to be 12,656 persons or 86.8% White; 1,603 persons or 11.0% Black/African American; 34 persons or 0.2% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 119 persons or 0.8% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 65 persons or 0.5% of Some Other Race.

The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 426 persons or 2.9% of the total population.

Racial and Ethnic Demographics

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the racial composition of River Ridge (CDP) to be 12,656 persons or 86.8% White; 1,603 persons or 11.0% Black/African American; 34 persons or 0.2% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 119 persons or 0.8% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 65 persons or 0.5% of Some Other Race. The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 426 persons or 2.9% of the total population. Additionally, the 2000 Census introduces a new category for multiracial identity. The population reporting Two or More Races includes 111 persons or 0.8% of the total population.

The White population (12,656 persons or 86.8% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a decrease of 448 persons or 3.4% from the 1990 Census (White population of 13,104 persons or 88.5% of the total population in 1990) and a decrease of 2,226 persons or 15.0% from the 1980 Census (White population of 14,882 persons or 86.8% of the total population in 1980).

The Black/African American population (1,603 persons or 11.0% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 52 persons or 3.4% from the 1990 Census (Black/African American population of 1,551 persons or 10.5% of the total population in 1990) and a decrease of 528 persons or 24.8% from the 1980 Census (Black/African

American population of 2,131 persons or 12.4% of the total population in 1980).

The American Indian/Alaskan Native population (34 persons or 0.2% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 3 persons or 9.7% from the 1990 Census (American Indian/Alaskan Native population of 31 persons or 0.2% of the total population in 1990).

The Asian/Pacific Islander population (119 persons or 0.8% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 71 persons or 147.9% from the 1990 Census (Asian/Pacific Islander population of 48 persons or 0.3% of the total population in 1990).

The population that is categorized as Some Other Race (65 persons or 0.5% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a decrease of 1 person or 1.5% from the 1990 Census (Some Other Race population of 66 persons or 0.5% of the total population in 1990).

The 2000 Census reports that the population of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is 426 persons or 2.9% of the total population. This is a decrease of 14 persons or 3.2% from the 1990 Census (Hispanic/Latino population of 440 persons or 3.0% of the total population in 1990).

River Ridge (CDP): Age & Sex Demographics

Age Demographics

The 2000 Census reports the Age breakdown for River Ridge (CDP) at 3,305 persons or 22.7% of the total population are under eighteen years of age, 8,883 persons or 60.9% of the total population are eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 2,400 persons or 16.5% of the total population are sixty-five years and older.

The 1990 Census reported the Age breakdown for River Ridge (CDP) at 3,518 persons or 23.8% of the total population were under eighteen years of age, 9,508 persons or 64.2% of the total population were from eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 1,774 persons or 12.0% of the total population were sixty-five years and older.

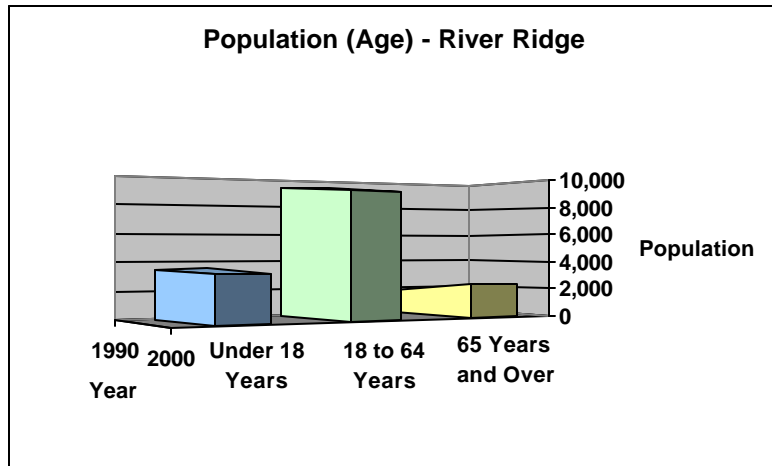
This shows an decrease from 1990 to 2000 for the population under eighteen years of age at 213 persons or 6.1%, a decrease for the population eighteen to sixty-four years of age at 625 persons or 6.6%, and an increase in the population sixty-five years and older at 626 persons or 35.3%.

Sex Demographics

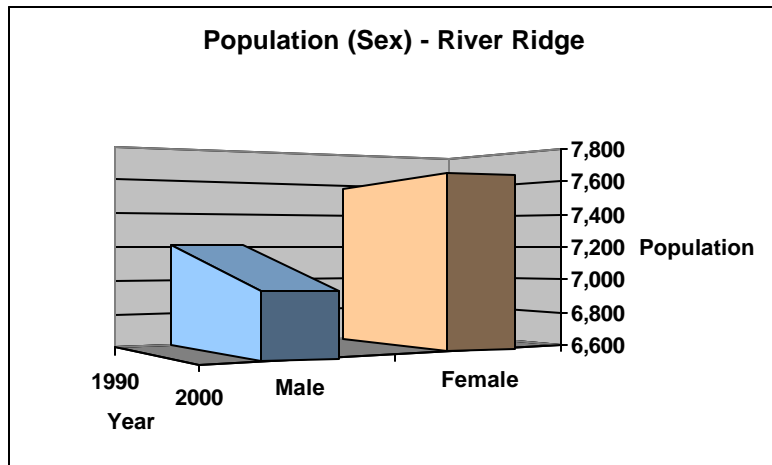
The 2000 Census reports the Sex breakdown for River Ridge (CDP) as 6,963 persons or 47.7% of the total population are Male and 7,625 persons or 52.3% of the total population are Female.

The 1990 Census reported the Sex breakdown for River Ridge (CDP) as 7,218 persons or 48.8% of the total population were Male and 7,582 persons or 51.2% of the total population were Female.

This shows a decrease from 1990 to 2000 for the Male population of 255 persons or 3.5% and an increase for the Female population of 43 persons or 0.6%.



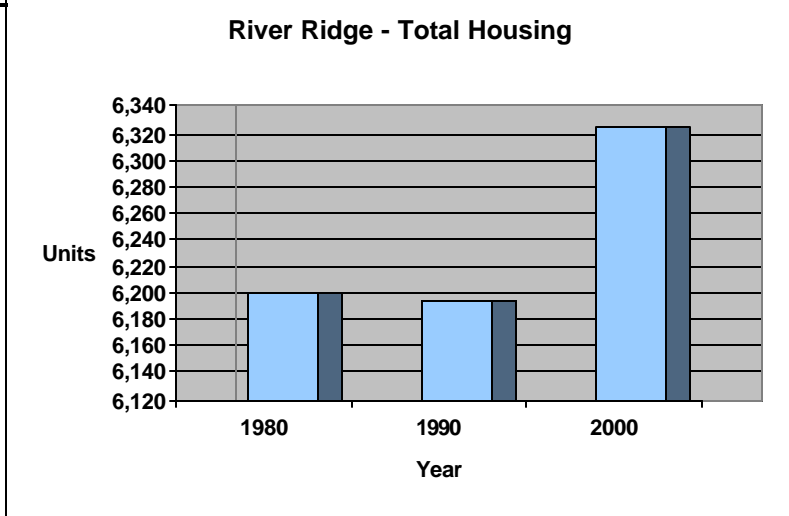
The 2000 Census reports the Age breakdown for River Ridge (CDP) at 3,305 persons or 22.7% are under eighteen years of age, 8,883 persons or 60.9% are eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 2,400 persons or 16.5% are sixty-five years and older. 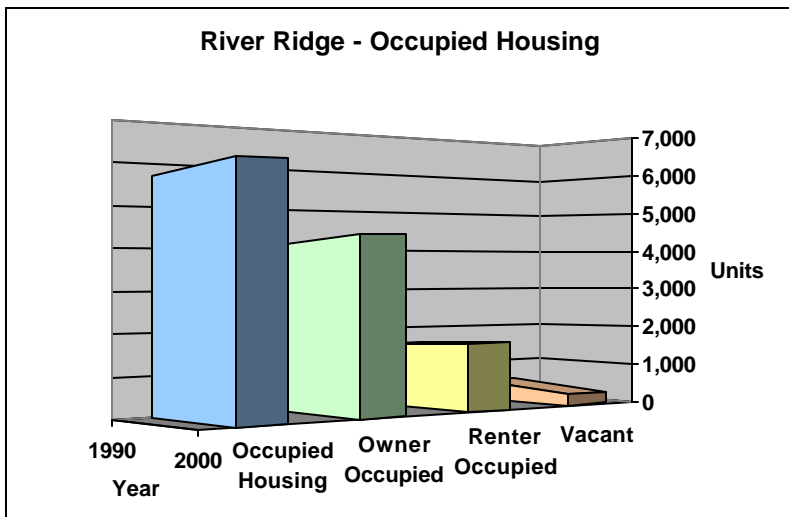

The 2000 Census indicates that River Ridge (CDP) has 6,325 total housing units. This is 131 housing units higher or a 2.1% gain since the 1990 Census and 126 units higher or a 2.0% gain over the 1980 Census.



The 2000 Census indicates that River Ridge (CDP) has 6,030 occupied housing units or 95.3% of total housing. This is a 318 occupied unit increase or a 5.6% gain since the 1990 Census.

Total Housing

The 2000 Census indicates that River Ridge (CDP) has 6,325 total housing units. This is 131 housing units higher or a 2.1% gain since the 1990 Census, which had a total of 6,194 housing units. Total housing units available in the 2000 Census are 126 units higher or a 2.0% gain over the 1980 Census, which had a total of 6,199 housing units.

Housing Occupancy

The 2000 Census indicates that River Ridge (CDP) has 6,030 occupied housing units or 95.3% of total housing. This is a 318 occupied unit increase or a 5.6% gain since the 1990 Census (5,712 occupied housing units or 92.2% of total housing in 1990).

Owner occupied housing consists of 4,349 occupied units or 72.1% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 230 units or 5.6% in owner occupied housing since the 1990 Census (4,119 owner occupied housing units or 72.1% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

Renter occupied housing consists of 1,681 occupied units or 27.9% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 88 units or 5.5% in renter occupied housing since the 1990 Census (1,593 renter occupied housing units or 27.9% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

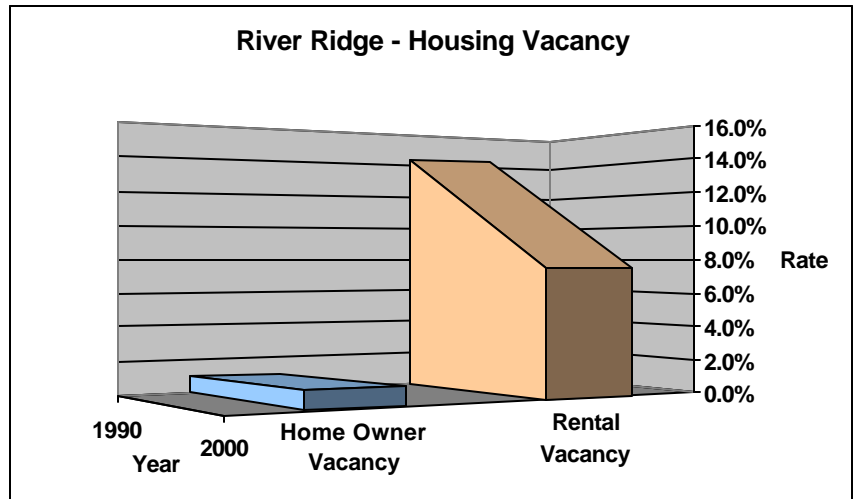
Vacant Housing

Vacant housing consists of 295 unoccupied units or 4.7% of total housing, which includes 20 units that are classified as seasonal/recreational/occasional use. This is a decrease of 187 units or 38.8% in vacant housing since the 1990 Census (482 vacant housing units or 7.8% of the total housing in 1990).

Vacancy Rate

The Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 1.1% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate increase of 0.1% or a 10.0 percent change since the 1990 Census (1.0% Homeowner Vacancy Rate in 1990).

The Rental Vacancy Rate is 7.5% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate decrease of 6.9% or a 47.9 percent change since the 1990 Census (14.4% Rental Vacancy Rate in 1990).



The 2000 Census indicates that the Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 1.1% and the Rental Vacancy Rate is 7.5%.

POPULATION HIGHLIGHTS

River Ridge (CDP) has experienced a decline in total population (-14.9% since 1980 and -1.4% since 1990). The primary factors for this trend are the change in the White population (-15.0% since 1980 and -3.4% since 1990) and the change in the Black/African American population (-24.8% since 1980 but +3.4% since 1990).

The population aged 65 and over shows an increase of 35.3% since 1990.
