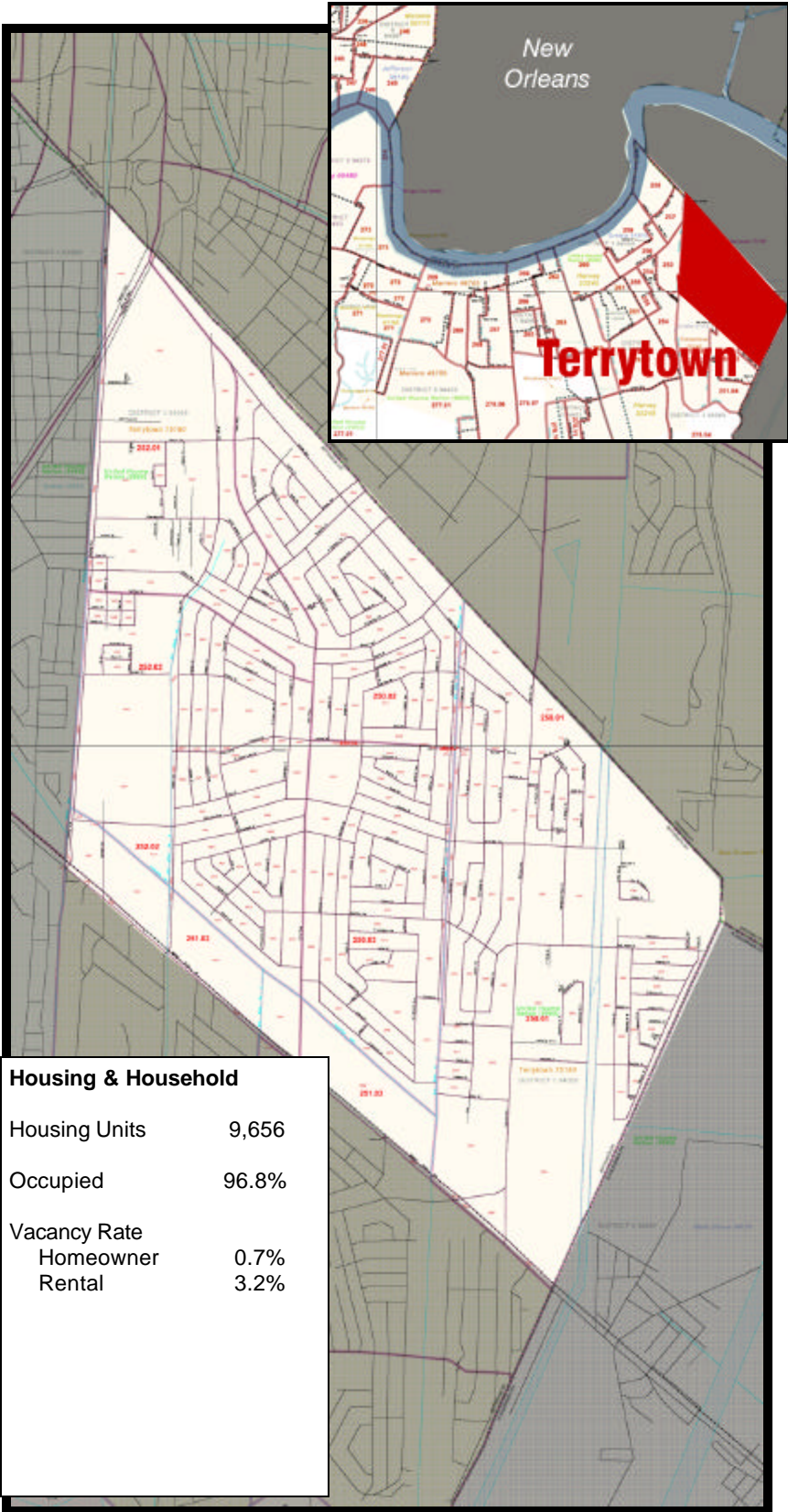

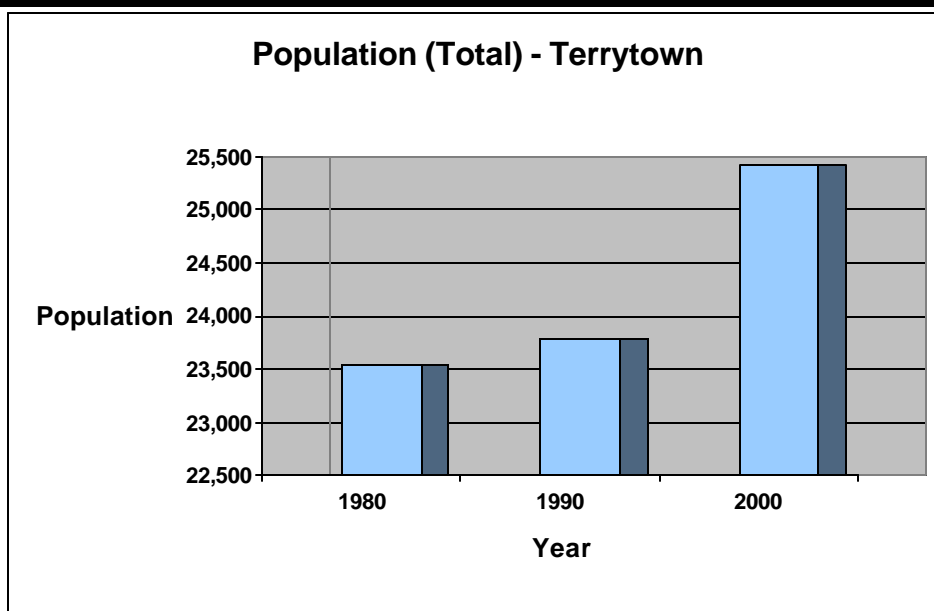

Terrytown (CDP): Total Population

Total Population

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the total population of Terrytown (CDP) to be 25,430 persons. This is an increase of 1,643 persons or 6.9% from the 1990 Census (total population of 23,787 persons) and an increase of 1,882 persons or 8.0% from the 1980 Census (total population of 23,548 persons).



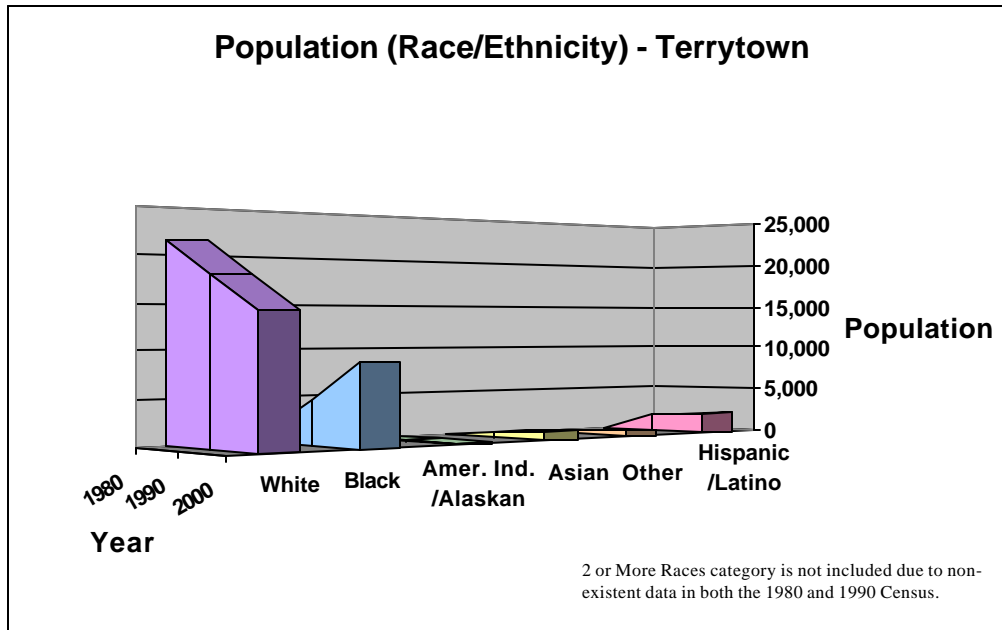

Terrytown (CDP): Racial/Ethnic Demographics



The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the racial composition of Terrytown (CDP) to be 14,216 persons or 55.9% White; 8,813 persons or 34.7% Black/African American; 130 persons or 0.5% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 897 persons or 3.5% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 690 persons or 2.7% of Some Other Race.

The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 2,206 persons or 8.7% of the total population.

Racial and Ethnic Demographics

The data contained in the 2000 Census reports the racial composition of Terrytown (CDP) to be 14,216 persons or 55.9% White; 8,813 persons or 34.7% Black/African American; 130 persons or 0.5% American Indian/Alaskan Native; 897 persons or 3.5% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 690 persons or 2.7% of Some Other Race. The population comprised of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is reported to be 2,206 persons or 8.7% of the total population. Additionally, the 2000 Census introduces a new category for multiracial identity. The population reporting Two or More Races includes 684 persons or 2.7% of the total population.

The White population (14,216 persons or 55.9% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a decrease of 3,697 persons or 20.6% from the 1990 Census (White population of 17,913 persons or 75.3% of the total population in 1990) and a decrease of 7,453 persons or 34.4% from the 1980 Census (White population of 21,669 persons or 92.0% of the total population in 1980).

The Black/African American population (8,813 persons or 34.7% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 4,114 persons or 87.6% from the 1990 Census (Black/African American population of 4,699 person or 19.8% of the total population in 1990) and an increase of 7,672 per-

sons or 672.4% from the 1980 Census (Black/African American population of 1,141 persons or 4.9% of the total population in 1980).

The American Indian/Alaskan Native population (130 persons or 0.5% of the 2000 Census total population) shows a decrease of 3 persons or 2.3% from the 1990 Census (American Indian/Alaskan Native population of 133 persons or 0.6% of the total population in 1990).

The Asian/Pacific Islander population (897 persons or 3.5% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 192 persons or 27.2% from the 1990 Census (Asian/Pacific Islander population of 705 persons or 3.0% of the total population in 1990).

The population that is categorized as Some Other Race (690 persons or 2.7% of the 2000 Census total population) shows an increase of 353 persons or 104.8% from the 1990 Census (Some Other Race population of 337 persons or 1.4% of the total population in 1990).

The 2000 Census reports that the population of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity is 2,206 persons or 8.7% of the total population. This is an increase of 355 persons or 19.2% from the 1990 Census (Hispanic/Latino population of 1,851 persons or 7.8% of the total population in 1990).

Terrytown (CDP): Age & Sex Demographics

Age Demographics

The 2000 Census reports the Age breakdown for Terrytown (CDP) at 7,379 persons or 29.0% of the total population are under eighteen years of age, 16,040 persons or 63.1% of the total population are eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 2,011 persons or 7.9% of the total population are sixty-five years and older.

The 1990 Census reported the Age breakdown for Terrytown (CDP) at 6,770 persons or 28.5% of the total population were under eighteen years of age, 15,580 persons or 65.5% of the total population were from eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 1,437 persons or 6.0% of the total population were sixty-five years and older.

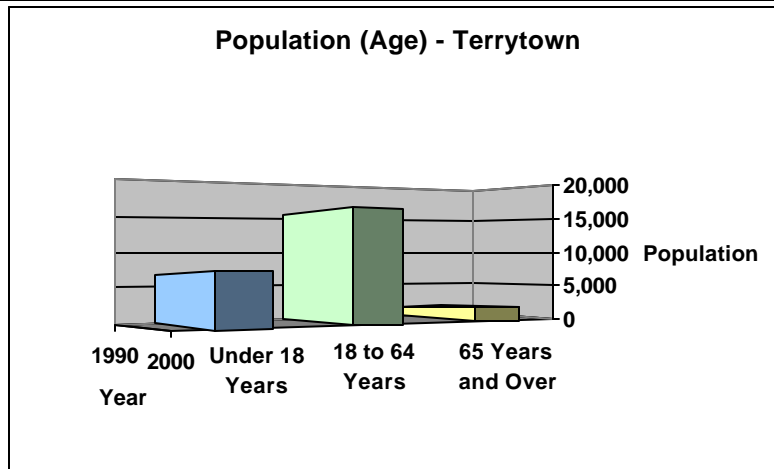
This shows an increase from 1990 to 2000 for the population under eighteen years of age at 609 persons or 9.0%, an increase for the population eighteen to sixty-four years of age at 460 persons or 3.0%, and an increase in the population sixty-five years and older at 574 persons or 39.9%.

Sex Demographics

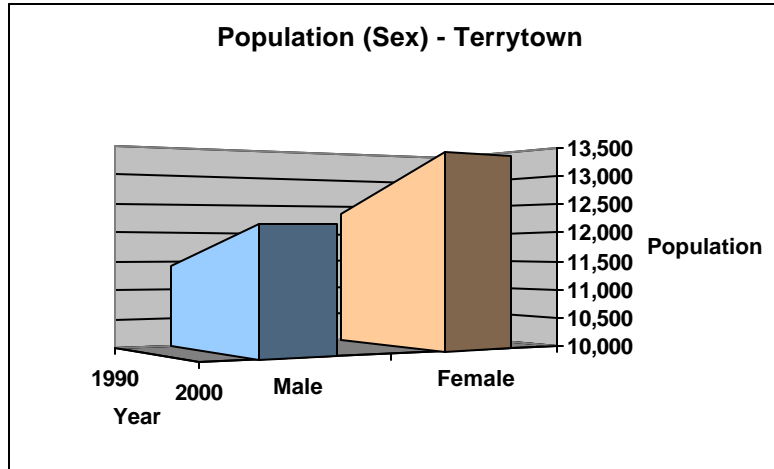
The 2000 Census reports the Sex breakdown for Terrytown (CDP) as 12,095 persons or 47.6% of the total population are Male and 13,335 persons or 52.4% of the total population are Female.

The 1990 Census reported the Sex breakdown for the Terrytown (CDP) as 11,438 persons or 48.1% of the total population were Male and 12,349 persons or 51.9% of the total population were Female.

This shows an increase from 1990 to 2000 for the Male population of 657 persons or 5.7% and an increase for the Female population of 986 persons or 8.0%.



The 2000 Census reports the Age breakdown for Terrytown (CDP) at 7,379 persons or 29.0% are under eighteen years of age, 16,040 persons or 63.1% are eighteen to sixty-four years of age, and 2,011 persons or 7.9% are sixty-five years and older. This shows an increase from 1990 to 2000 for the population under eighteen years of age at 609 persons or 9.0%, an increase for the population eighteen to sixty-four years of age at 460 persons or 3.0%, and an increase in the population sixty-five years and older at 574 persons or 39.9%.

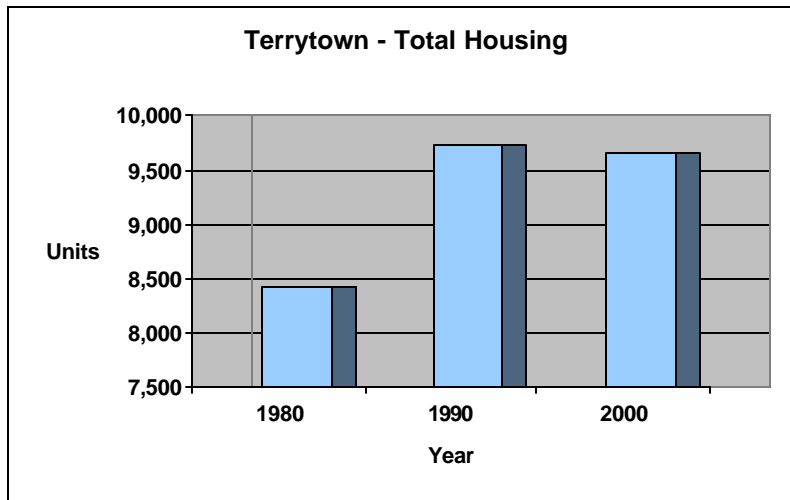

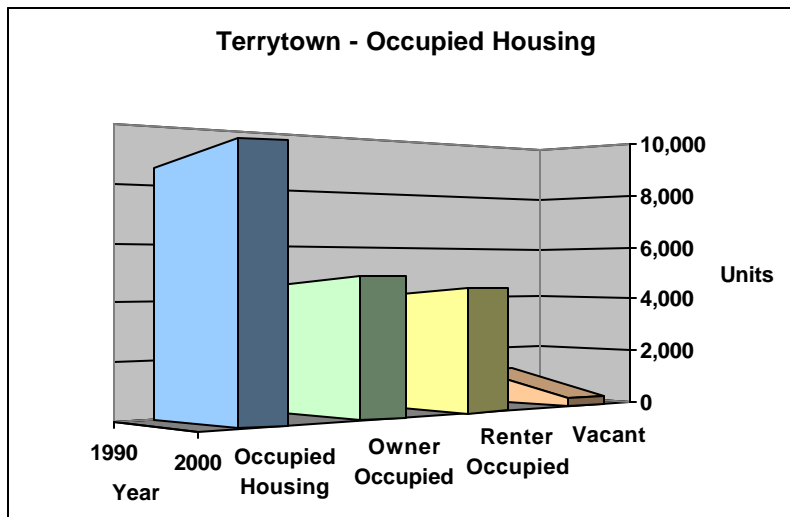

The 2000 Census indicates that Terrytown (CDP) has 9,656 total housing units. This is 70 housing units lower or a 0.7% loss since the 1990 Census and 1,238 units higher or a 14.7% gain over the 1980 Census.



The 2000 Census indicates that Terrytown (CDP) has 9,344 occupied housing units or 96.8% of total housing. This is a 762 occupied unit increase or a 8.9% gain since the 1990 Census.

Total Housing

The 2000 Census indicates that Terrytown (CDP) has 9,656 total housing units. This is 70 housing units lower or a 0.7% loss since the 1990 Census, which had a total of 9,726 housing units. Total housing units available in the 2000 Census are 1,238 units higher or a 14.7% gain over the 1980 Census, which had a total of 8,418 housing units.

Housing Occupancy

The 2000 Census indicates that Terrytown (CDP) has 9,344 occupied housing units or 96.8% of total housing. This is a 762 occupied unit increase or a 8.9% gain since the 1990 Census (8,582 occupied housing units or 88.2% of total housing in 1990).

Owner occupied housing consists of 4,946 occupied units or 52.9% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 451 units or 10.0% in owner occupied housing since the 1990 Census (4,495 owner occupied housing units or 52.4% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

Renter occupied housing consists of 4,398 occupied units or 47.1% of total occupied housing. This is an increase of 311 units or 7.6% in renter occupied housing since the 1990 Census (4,087 renter occupied housing units or 47.6% of the total occupied housing in 1990).

Terrytown (CDP): Housing Characteristics

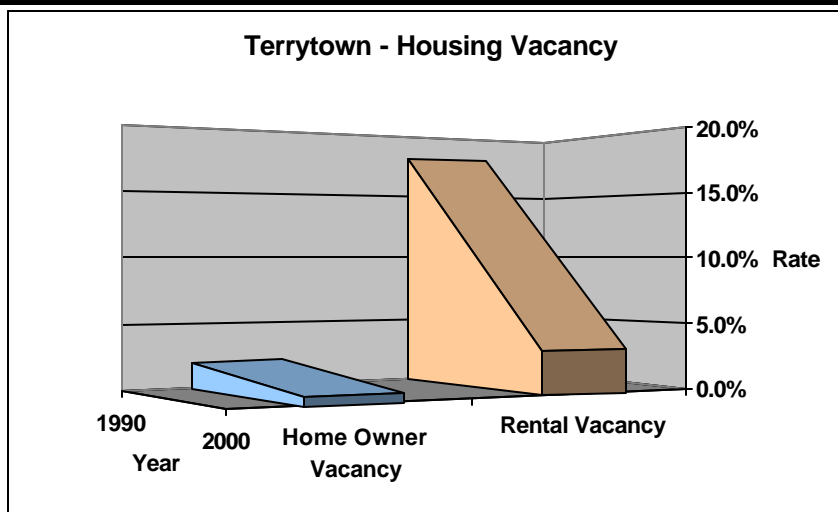
Vacant Housing

Vacant housing consists of 312 unoccupied units or 3.2% of total housing, which includes 17 units that are classified as seasonal/recreational/occasional use. This is a decrease of 832 units or 72.7% in vacant housing since the 1990 Census (1,144 vacant housing units or 11.8% of the total housing in 1990).

Vacancy Rate

The Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 0.7% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate decrease of 1.3% or a 65.0 percent change since the 1990 Census (2.0% Homeowner Vacancy Rate in 1990).

The Rental Vacancy Rate is 3.2% as of the 2000 Census. This is a rate decrease of 15.0% or a 82.4 percent change since the 1990 Census (18.2% Rental Vacancy Rate in 1990).



The 2000 Census indicates that the Homeowner Vacancy Rate is 0.7% and the Rental Vacancy Rate is 3.2%.

POPULATION HIGHLIGHTS

Terrytown (CDP) has experienced an increase in total population (8.0% since 1980 and 6.9% since 1990). The primary factor for this trend is the increase in the Black/African American population (87.6% since 1980 and 672.4% since 1990). However, this increase is partially offset by the decrease in the White population (-20.6% since 1990 and -34.4% since 1980).

The population aged 65 years and over has increase 39.9% since 1990.
