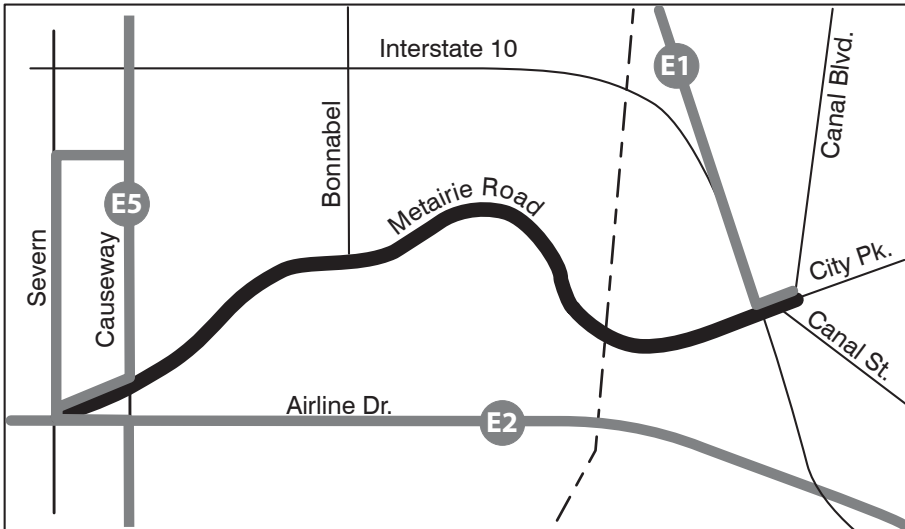

Route: The Metairie Road route starts at Severn and travels east on Metairie Road to the intersection of Canal Street and City Park Avenue. From this point, passengers can take the following RTA routes into New Orleans: RTA's 42-Canal Street, 27-Louisiana, and 91-Jackson-Esplanade buses and the 47-Canal Cemeteries streetcar. (Contact the RTA for their current schedules or visit their website at www.norta.com.)

The Metairie Road route connects with the following JeT routes: E5-Causeway at Causeway Blvd., E2-Airport at Airline and Severn, E1-Veterans at City Park Ave. and Canal Blvd. (Cemeteries)

Holiday Schedule: The Metairie Road route does not operate on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Good Friday, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

⊗ Denotes bus going to/from bus garage. When ⊗ is in front of time, ex., ⊗ 6:09, a new bus is coming on to the route. When ⊗ is behind the time, ex., 10:53 ⊗, the bus is leaving the route.



Did you know? Except for 18 months after Hurricane Katrina, there has been some type of transit service on Metairie Rd. for over 90 years! From 1915 - 34 the Napoleon streetcar line, operated by New Orleans Railway & Light Co., traveled this route. In 1935, NOPSI (New Orleans Public Service, Inc.) created the Metairie Rd. bus line as a replacement to this portion of the rail line. This new bus traveled from Canal Blvd. and City Park Ave. to Severn. In 1983, RTA took over its operation and then on April 1, 1985 Jefferson Transit assumed its operation.

The Half Fare card allows you to ride all JeT buses for half price. This includes regular bus fares and transfers.

To get your Half Fare card, bring your Medicare card and a picture ID to one of the Jefferson Transit offices (see locations on page 1).

There is no charge to get the half-fare card.
